

Dutch White Clover

2 ounces for:

250 square feet new seeding

500 square feet overseeding

Please remember that a little goes a long way when using Dutch White Clover as a pollinator-friendly ground cover. There really can be too much of a good thing!

There are many reasons not to “overdo it”

- Although it is a wonderful and hardy addition for bee lawns, it is NOT native to our area. It can become invasive with too much planting.
- It has been in short supply because a lot of folks have been over-planting it.
- Greater floral diversity is one of the best things you can provide for our pollinator friends. If you already have a good amount of clover growing in your yard, consider adding Creeping Thyme, Self-Heal or Yaak Yarrow to your lawn. The bees will thank you and it will help your lawn flourish.
