
FULL SHADE PLANTING PALETTE

PLANTING NOTES

Follow these notes to place your plants in the best location for them to thrive.

Always space all plants 15-inches from the center of one plant to the center of the next one, even if the plant tags say to place them differently.

Plant 5 should mostly be placed beside the street. This is a salt tolerant plant anc will do better in the areas that receives more street salt in wintertime.

The remaining plants can be scattered throughout the boulevard in groupings as shown.
