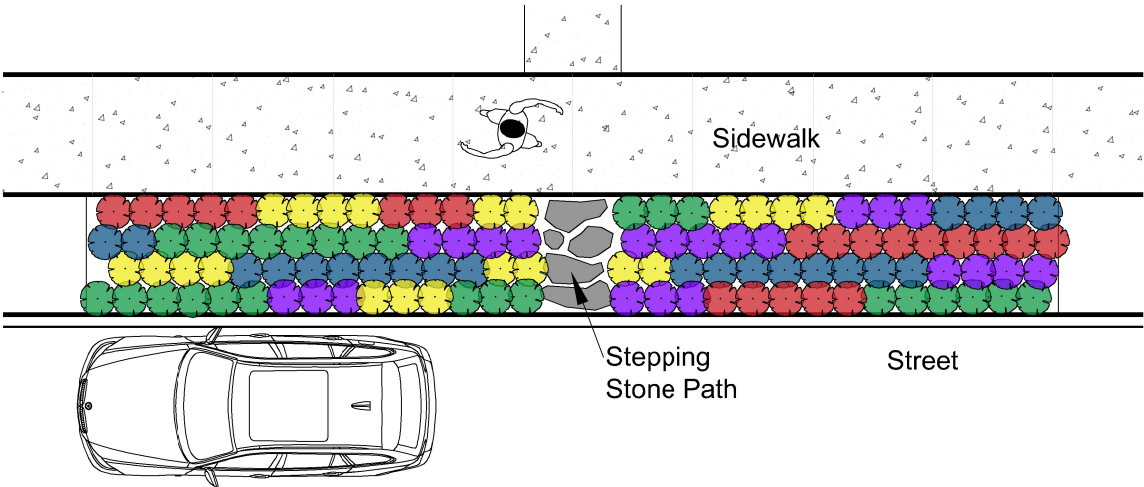
PLANTING NOTES

Follow these notes to place your plants in the best location for them to thrive.

Always space all plants 15-inches from the center of one plant to the center of the next one, even if the plant tags say to place them differently.

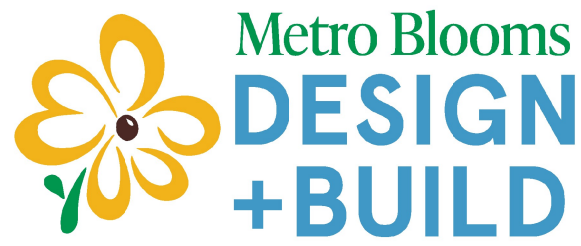
Plant 5 should mostly be placed beside the street. This is a salt tolerant plant and will do better in the areas that receives more street salt in wintertime.

The remaining plants can be scattered throughout the boulevard in groupings as shown.



PLANT LIST (Possible Substitutions)

- Plant 1: Bradbury's Monarda or Penstemon or Jacob's Ladder
- Plant 2: Zigzag Goldenrod (Elm-Leaved Goldenrod)
- Plant 3: Wild Geranium (Columbine or Tall Thimbleweed)
- Plant 4: Big Leaved Aster (Heart Leaved Aster or Short's Aster)
- Plant 5: Curly Styled Wood Sedge (Plains Oval Sedge or Long Beaked Sedge)
