STEP 1:

Cover drain holes with filter fabric. You can use a scrap of an old t-shirt or a piece of woven/mesh fabric Add mulch or small rock to the bottom of your planter to fill space, reduce weight and create air pockets for root growth.

STEP 2:

Then add potting soil to provide nutrients for your new plants. A good potting soil mix will drain well and not dry out too fast.

STEP 3:

Move soil aside to create a hole the size of the plant pot. Take the plant out of its small store pot and loosen the roots. Then place the new plant in the hole so the top of the base of plant is in line with the new soil level.
